Outreach

DAY CENTER

During COVID-19, many service providers closed their doors. Citrus Heights HART did the opposite. During the winter months and COVID lockdown, we hosted a drop-in day center for our homeless neighbors. We provided hot food, resource referrals, charging stations, and community.

VACCINATIONS, SHOWERS, AND MEALS

Citrus Heights HART is partnering with Dignity Health and other community organizations to provide free food, mainline resources, and COVID-19 vaccines to our unhoused neighbors.

Programs

WINTER SHELTER

The Citrus Heights Winter Sanctuary is a rotating emergency shelter program for Citrus Heights residents operated by CH HART in partnership with the local faith-based community and other volunteers. The program begins in December and runs until the end of February. The program provides dinner and to-go breakfast; cot, sleeping bag, and secure overnight storage for small items/bicycles.

AT RISK STUDENT PROGRAMS

The Underground Clothing Connection Store, located in Sunrise Mall, provides free clothing for students and their families in the San Juan Unified School District. We are currently looking for volunteers to act as store staff. The store is open Wednesdays and Saturdays, 11AM-4PM. We are also working on providing workforce development, digital up-skilling and other programs.

NAVIGATOR SUPPORT

Citrus Heights HART supports the City's Navigator who acts as the main outreach specialist in the county's coordinated system and works to assess and provide connections to services for the homeless. To ensure that clients are given access to services designed explicitly for them, the navigator does most of her work in the field by engaging potential clients where they live.
